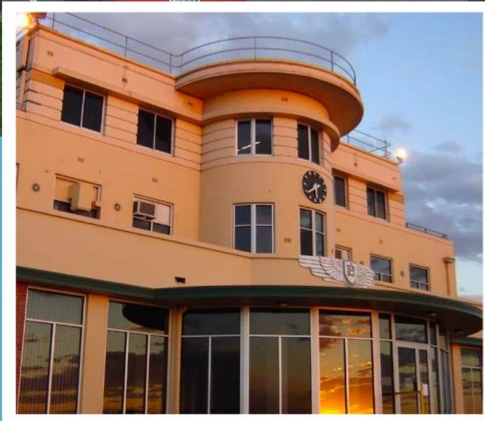




Brisbane General Aviation Terminal

The Archerfield General Aviation Terminal is a shared terminal used by a number of aircraft operators. There is parking available in front of the terminal however parking fees can apply if the vehicle is parked there for extended periods.



About Archerfield Airport

Once the main airport in Brisbane, Archerfield Airport holds a rich history from the time it was first established in the 1930s.

Today, Archerfield Airport serves as a major general aviation airport and secondary airport for the city. Within the property are a licensed pub, aircraft hire, flight training facilities and a heritage-listed cemetery.

Its art deco passenger terminal remains intact from the time it was built in 1941. This fully preserved structure pretty much gives the present a glimpse of the past. A public aviation museum also exists within the airport.
